
DRAW A BUCKET OF WATER




This is sung four times thus; then a fifth time, a little faster, with the following serving as the last line:

And we'll all go 'round the mulberry bush.

ACTION:

For four players: Each couple joins hands straight across (R in L and L in R, facing each other), one couple having their hands above the other couple's hands.



Players push their hands back and forth in time with the singing. They should be moved from the shoulders, elbows bent; that is, not moving the body. At the end of the first time, players 2 and 4 raise their joined hands and lower the arch behind player 1.

Second time: Player 3 "pops under" the same way.

Third time: Player 2 pops under.
